GENERAL ORDER REGARDING  
APPLICABILITY OF RULE 3007(C) OF THE  
AMENDED FEDERAL RULES OF BANKRUPTCY PROCEDURE

AND NOW this 27<sup>th</sup> day of NOVEMBER, 2007, it appearing that Rule 3007(c) of the amended Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure which become effective December 1, 2007, is in conflict with Local Rule 3007-1, but permits the Court to order that the Rule shall not be effective with respect to omnibus objections to claims, it is therefore

ORDERED that pending further amendment of the Local Rules, Order of this Court, or an Order by an individual Judge of this Court, Rule 3007(c) of the amended Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure shall not be applicable to omnibus objections that are filed in accordance with Local Rule 3007-1.
