GENERAL ORDER

WHEREAS, by General Orders dated September 20, 2005 and September 27, 2006, respectively (the "General Orders"), this Court adopted certain interim rules and forms as a consequence of the enactment on April 20, 2005 of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (Pub. L. No. 109-08, 119 Stat. 23) ("BAPCPA");

WHEREAS, unless Congress acts to the contrary, certain new rules and amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure will take effect on December 1, 2008, which rule amendments and new rules implement the substantive and procedural changes to the Bankruptcy Code made by BAPCPA;

WHEREAS, the rules amendments and new rules, to be effective December 1, 2008, are intended to supersede the interim rules¹;

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that, effective December 1, 2008, the General Orders, adopting interim rules and forms are VACATED; provided however, Interim Rule 5012 shall remain effective until further order of court.
